From the Director's Desk...

Dear New Life Friend,

As we write you this month our hearts are overwhelmed by all of the calls we have been receiving from women who are hurting. One after another they come to us unfolding their plight in life and needing help and hope for their situations. They are desperately searching for answers to their problems. Scripture tells us in Matthew 16:26, "For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world and lose his own soul? Or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?"



Approximately two years ago a pastor and his wife brought their young daughter and granddaughter to us. They were obviously in deep anguish over their daughter's condition. Their hearts were broken and distraught by some of the bad choices she had made in her life. We accepted CJ and her daughter Carlie into the program. This month we want to share her testimony with you. CJ writes...

"I was brought up in a loving, Christian home. Early on I came to know Christ as my Savior but did not understand the concept of forgiveness. I thought it was a religion of do's and don'ts and that didn't make any sense to me. In my teens I began to use drugs excessively and even overdosed on several occasions. In my downfall, I started using crack cocaine; it got a hold of me, and I could not stop. Drugs became my god. I found myself doing things I never dreamed I would do. I knew if things did not change I would lose my daughter and family forever. I am so grateful that God saw my heart and desperation and heard my parents' prayers. God led my daughter and me to New Life Home for Women and Children where I rededicated my life to Christ. My life began to change as I was immersed in Scripture reading and memorization. The verses I learned as a child began to make sense and I began to find real spiritual insight. God has walked with me through many tests and trials and I have grown stronger in my faith. During my first year at New Life, the Lord didn't just deliver me from drugs but, He has set me free! When I rededicated my life to Jesus, a heavy burden of sin and awareness of His love and forgiveness flowed into me like I have never experienced before. I am thankful to now be able to teach and raise my daughter up in the things of the Lord. I am feeling such gratitude for New Life Home and its staff because, today, I know without this wonderful home, I would be dead, and without direction, and lost in sin. I am graduating from the New Life Program and am moving to N. Carolina where I will be attending John Wesley College. Thank you loving Jesus for your mercy and grace."

What is a soul worth? We can't put a dollar figure on it. Here are two precious lives that God has redeemed for His purposes. There are yet so many we must reach. Are you willing to invest in a life? If your daughter, granddaughter, or sister was in need –how much would you be willing to do to see their lives made whole?

God has called us and set in place a home where there is safety and restoration. It is a ministry that doesn't charge the women for their participation in the program. We depend upon God's people who are willing to give so that women and their children can find a new life.
