I came out of a very difficult past; my parents were unable to care for me and I was placed into the foster care system at a very young age. I moved from home to home and was abused physically, sexually, and emotionally. I went through life without meaning and without direction. Life became trivial, petty, and pointless. I had this emptiness and a longing for something or someone to fill that void. I tried many different things to fill me, but they only brought momentary happiness and satisfaction. I was left wondering who I was and what my purpose in life was—hurting and lost, I sought for an answer.

A year and a half ago God made a way for me to come to New Life Home for Women and Children. This was a place where God started working in my life and showing me the importance of having a relationship with Him. It was through these alone times with God I began to discover wholeness, direction in life, and the importance of forgiveness. I began to understand that God has a plan and purpose for my life and that all of the things that I went through in my past God can turn around and use for good.

In the fall, I plan on attending Zion Bible College. I have a heart for children and I have always wanted to reach out to children in orphanages. I want to be able to share what God has done in my life and offer others hope. I want to reach out to others with the love of God. Before I had God in my life, I didn't know how to love. I felt insignificant. Now, I have discovered that God not only has a plan for my life but His plan reaches beyond me to bring the hope of "new life" to others. Jeremiah 29:11 states, "I know the plans I have for you declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future".



We rejoice in all that God is doing in and through New Life Home. It is our prayer that you would catch a glimpse of the work and would be willing to invest in the home in order for women, just like Rose, to have an opportunity to find a "New Life".
