I was finally at the end of myself. My addiction had taken everything from me. Little did I know that there was a great big loving God who saw and heard everything and was waiting patiently for me to realize that I needed Him. I had lost all hope, I wasn't living- I was merely existing. This merciful God who I now serve joyfully and with all my heart has forgiven me and washed me clean. He has delivered me, healed my mind and body; and, set me free. He has given me a 'new life' and a future and a hope. How ironic, when I needed a new life, God sent me right to the doors of New Life Home. What an amazing God that I serve! God also blessed me with a beautiful daughter 17 years ago who had witnessed my selfishness and destruction. He has done a work in her heart, for she has been able to forgive me for all the pain and stress that I had caused her when she was at a young and tender age. She comes faithfully to see me every week. I can't thank Him enough for all that He has done. Now, my life is getting back on track again. I've been able to renew my license as a nursing assistant. God is truly a restoring God - He keeps His promises and 'restores the years that the locust has eaten' (Joel 2:25 KJV). I am honored and privileged to serve Him all the days of my life.
