As many of you are aware, George and I have been in Jacksonville, Florida where George underwent a liver transplant. We are so grateful to the Lord for His grace and sustaining power as we have been away from our family, ministry, and support system.

We are happy to report our time here is coming to a close and we will be returning home in just a few short weeks. God has truly been faithful and has given George a "new life".

In our absence we thank God for our faithful staff and our Board of Directors who have stood in the gap for us. The work at New Life Home continues forward. The house is filled with women and children seeking God's help and needing restoration for their lives. In answer to our prayers we are seeing lives changed, families reunited, and miracles taking place in the hearts of these precious ones.

While we are so thankful for all that is being done, yet our hearts are burdened by the deficit we are now experiencing at the home. For the last several months income has dropped significantly. Therefore, the bills are piling up, the staff cannot be paid, and the daily needs of the home are not being met.

What we need is a boost to get us back on track. It will take approximately \$50,000.00 to help alleviate our past due debt.
